MID-TRIMESTER – NEW THINGS ARE HAPPENING


We are just past the mid-point of the second trimester and the week saw us undergoing final unit assessments in Language Arts, Math, and Social Studies! It was a lot of work but the students were troopers and we got it all done!

We are looking forward to continuing work on blending and isolating sounds in simple words in Language Arts. Please feel free to continue working on the IXL sections that were assigned for “homework” during AISM’s virtual learning day on Monday. Practicing these skills will help support your child’s learning for the rest of the semester. In writing, the students were introduced to some new concepts and skills. They are learning to write sentences with SWAG (Start with a capital letter, Write neatly, A space between words, Give punctuation). They made a “spaceman” to help them remember to create spaces between the words they write. They were also introduced to a simple chart (rubric) that details how to be a “four star writer”. We have started to learn how to do peer editing and are using this chart as a way to know how to improve our writing.

In math we have started working on numbers 20-100. Next week (February 7) will be the 100th day of school. We will do a special project to celebrate that day.
