



AISM Parents,

Early this month (May 6-17), students taking French and Arabic in Grades 2 – 10 took, for the second time this year, the Avant STAMP (**ST**Andards based **M**Measurement of **P**roficiency) to assist our students in their French and Arabic\* Learning Proficiency.

Please note that it takes up to 5-7 days to process the results. This assessment is designed as a “**DIAGNOSTIC**” tool for our second language program.

It will help us:

- Assist your students in their **areas of growth**
- See their **progress over time**
- Understand the areas that still need to be mastered

\*One quick note: we have been using the Spanish MAP test since the start of last school year. This is done, once again, to help our teaching team know the areas that our students need to focus on.

Just like the MAP test, STAMP is an adaptive test “**designed to adjust to a student’s level so s/he is challenged, but not overwhelmed.**” Students are exposed to real-world questions and are tested in four different sections: **Reading, Writing, Listening, and Speaking.**

The results for most students\* will be sent home this afternoon. You will receive a packet with:

- Your student’s results from September, for the students who took the test at that time (hard copy)
- Your student’s results for May (hard copy) – along with the Scaled Scores in Reading and Listening for Grades 7-10
