

**Message from the Board of Trustees:
AISM Announces Virtual Class for Two More Weeks**

The Director and Board of the American International School of Monrovia discussed developments surrounding the COVID-19 pandemic yesterday evening and determined that it would be in the best interest of our community to extend virtual school for another two weeks, through Friday, April 3.

Faculty will be preparing for a level II model of virtual classes over the next few days. Please have patience as the faculty upgrade their lesson plans (and online lesson bank) to adjust to this new reality in providing extended learning direction and assignments in advance.

Should your family have temporarily located outside of Monrovia, this will enable your student to continue interacting with their teachers, and not disrupt their learning.

You may find it encouraging to know that AISM was at the forefront of virtual training during the 2015-16 Ebola crisis. In contrast to some other schools, which closed due to that epidemic, the school continued providing virtual education for five months.

The Board will be reviewing the overall situation regarding the need for virtual learning on a weekly basis, and continue to communicate as needed.

Please know that AISM maintains its commitment to teaching and learning at all times.
